



FAQs regarding the coverage for situation involving the Swine Flu and travel insurance policies issued by iTravelinsured.

A traveler with an existing iTI travel insurance policy would be covered:

- a. For trip cancellation if they contract swine flu and are unable to go on the trip.
- b. For trip cancellation if travel restrictions due to an outbreak of swine flu at the destination prevents travel to the destination. Travel restrictions preventing travel to the destination must be government issued. If there are not government issued restrictions cancellation will not be covered.
- c. For trip cancellation if travel restrictions due to an outbreak of swine flu in the US prevents the traveler from leaving the US. There must be an official quarantine preventing travel outside of the US for coverage to be in effect.
- d. For trip interruption if travel restrictions due to an outbreak of swine flu during the trip forces the traveler to return to the US before the trip is finished. Trip interruption would apply if there is an official mandate for a total quarantine during the trip.
- e. For trip interruption if the traveler contracts swine flu while traveling and is forced to return to the US before the trip is finished.
